

# St. Joe Valley Agility Club AKC Agility Trials September 23 & 24, 2017



Thank you for entering the SJVAC Agility Trial!

Please check the final entry confirmation for your dog(s). If you find any errors, please notify the trial secretary via email at [agilityentry@agilitytrialservices.com](mailto:agilityentry@agilitytrialservices.com) (preferred) or by phone at (815) 469-5525. If you do not get a response from me, I did not get your email, so please follow up with a phone call. Pre-trial move-ups must be received not later than 6:00 pm CDT on Monday, September 19, 2016. Day to day move-ups must be made by the close of Saturday's trial for the Sunday trial. Close of the trial will be considered when the ribbons have been awarded for the last class of the day.

Dogs in the Master classes will run before those in the Excellent classes and Novice B will run before Novice A for each jump height. Dogs in the Preferred program will run after dogs in the Regular program in their corresponding jump height. Entry numbers are preliminary, and subject to change contingent upon the move-up entries or withdrawals that may not have been received.

Walkthroughs for the Master/Excellent classes will be split 24"-1<sup>st</sup> part 20" & 2<sup>nd</sup> part 20" Walk Walk-Run then 16" Walk & 12", 8", 4" Walk then Run all.

## Check in:

Self check in will be near the Trial Secretary's table. All dogs not having an AKC height card must be measured prior to competing. **If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Be sure to arrive early enough before your judging time.** Any exhibitor who runs without having their dog measured will lose any qualifying score earned. Unless you already check-marked on the entry form "My Dog Needs To Be Measured", please notify the Trial Secretary that your dog needs to be measured.

There is a restaurant located on site. No human food is allowed on the turf. Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the grounds clean. **Please be sure your dogs have been walked before running. SJVAC will be fined \$175 for any dog that eliminates on the turf.** Handlers who do not clean up after their dogs will be dismissed from the trial with no monies refunded. Do not exercise dogs on the landscaping directly in front of the building. There is plenty of other green space available for your dogs.

## Set up:

**Friday night crating set up will be allowed AFTER all the equipment is unloaded** from the Rush'N'Around trailer. Unloading will begin at 2:00 pm CDT at the northwest end of the building. will be open at 6:30 am CDT on Saturday and Sunday.

Crating areas will be marked on Friday evening for the weekend. Crates may be left over night, but the SJVAC and the Southland Center will not be responsible for personal articles left at the site. No grooming is allowed in the building; no dogs may be left overnight. There is ample crate space when allocated appropriately. **Matting is required under crates and X-pens. No X-pens for single dwellers.**
